Three Essential Understandings for our Counsel

1. Understand the Situation – Redeemed Saints, Sufferers, and Sinners

2. Understand the Stakes - Rewarded Perseverance

3. Understand the Solution – Reliant Gospel Counsel

- Speak the truth in love to one another (Eph. 4:15, 25)

- Rejoice with one another (Ro 12:15)
- Weep with one another (Ro 12:15)
- Counsel/Instruct one another (Ro 15:14)
- Greet one another (Ro 16:16, 1 Pet 5:14)
- Sing to one another (Eph 5:19)
- Teach and admonish one another (Col 3:16)
- Build up one another (1 Th 5:11)
- Spur one another on (Heb 10:24)
